Practice Fields Maintenance Procedures

All teams will be responsible for field maintenance at the end of their practice. Your duties at the end of practice are as follows:

- Put bases back in equipment shed.
- Place plugs inside all anchors.
- Rake the entire infield area.
- Rake any gopher mounds in the outfield.
- Fill any low areas at home plate.
- Fill any low areas at the pitchers rubber.
- Place rakes back into equipment shed.
- Police the area for any trash.
- Make sure shed is locked up when you leave.

This is required by all teams who practice on these fields. Dereliction of duty will have the following consequences.

- 1st Offense – Warning
- 2nd Offense – Fine to pay someone else to do your work.
- 3rd Offense – Loss of Practice Fields.

I do not want to hand out fines or take practice fields from any team, so please help take care of the fields. The City of Bixby will take care of mowing the fields, fertilizing, and weed control. No one is allowed to use any herbicides without approval by the association. There will be times when some additional work may be required to get the fields in playable condition. I am looking for a group of volunteers who will help with this process. Basically, we will need help with drying fields after a rain storm. Please contact me if you can help.
